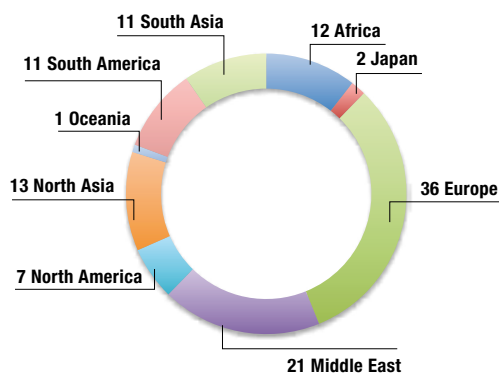
### BioVision.Nxt

- offers a unique opportunity to bright students in Life Sciences and related fields from the best institutions/universities from around the world, to attend the Forum and broaden their perspectives;
- creates a unique dialogue between those who made a breakthrough in Life Sciences and those who will make the news tomorrow;
- aims at fostering dialogue on Life Sciences future developments impacts on society in both the Western world and developing countries.

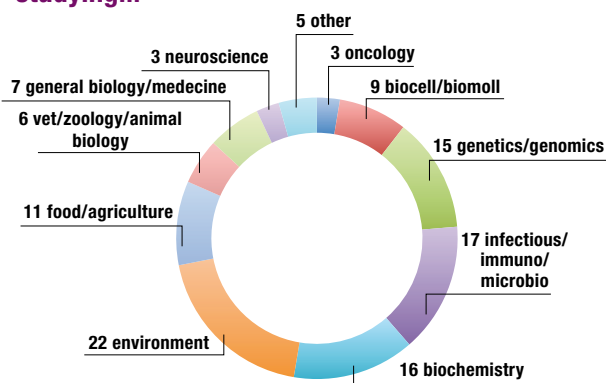
Today the BioVision.Nxt Alumni represent a group of 380 persons throughout the world (before the 2011 edition).

In 2011, the BioVision.Nxt programme selected 114 promising researchers.

Criteria of selection were scientific excellence (PhD level or post doctorate in Life Sciences fields), but also involvement in civil society and mobility. Profiles range between Chinese students studying in France at the Ecole Normale Supérieure, Uzbekistani studying in Malaysia, Colombian achieving a post doctorate in biochemistry in Colombia after a PhD in Canada at McGill University...

As the Nxt community intends to allow BioVision to broaden its perspectives, developing countries represent over 50% of the selection, and the split between men and women is 46-54%.
